

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

DRAG SPECIALTIES ONE-PIECE SEATS FOR FXR MODELS

ATTENTION INSTALLER (if other than owner): Please forward this instruction sheet to the purchaser of this product. These instructions contain valuable information necessary to the end user.

INTRODUCTION: These instructions describe the procedure for properly installing Drag seats onto 82-91 FXR models.

Review instructions carefully before beginning, as they contain important information. Please retain for future reference.

Particularly important information is distinguished in these instructions by the following notations.

NOTE: A NOTE provides key information to make procedures easier or clearer.

CAUTION: A CAUTION indicates special procedures that must be followed to avoid damage to the motorcycle and/or accessories.

WARNING!: A WARNING indicates special procedures that must be followed to avoid injury to a motorcycle operator or person inspecting or repairing the motorcycle.

TO MOUNT A ONE-PIECE SEAT IN PLACE OF TWO-SEAT APPLICATIONS:

Use the brackets supplied with the seat:

Tank/front seat bracket DS-490017
Rear seat bracket DS-490015

PROCEDURE:

1. Remove the original two-piece seat.
2. Discard the strap and hardware from the front of the rear seat.
3. Install bracket PART # DS-490017 to the two bolts on the rear of the gas tank.
4. Tap out the pins and remove the upper half of the two-piece seat hinge and latch assembly.
5. Follow installation procedures #3 through #6 for mounting a one-piece seat.

TO MOUNT A TWO-PIECE SEAT IN PLACE OF A ONE-PIECE SEAT APPLICATION:

See your local Harley-Davidson® dealer for a hinge and latch assembly plus the rear mounting brackets.

TOOLS REQUIRED:

- 1 - 1/2" combination wrench
- 1 - 7/16" combination wrench
- 1 - #3 Phillips screwdriver

TO MOUNT ONE-PIECE SEAT PROCEDURE:

Begin by placing the motorcycle on the side stand.

1. Remove the stock seat from the bike. Save the rear Phillips-head screw and plastic washer. They will be reused.
2. Remove the OEM bracket from the rear of the seat. Reuse this bracket and bolts on the new seat. The bolts should be snug, but loose enough to position the bracket.
3. Slip your new seat over the tab at the front of the frame, near the gas tank, and position the seat on the rear fender.
4. Center the seat in relation to the sissy bar and fender.
5. With the seat centered, position the rear bracket to line up with the hole in the fender. Remove the seat and tighten the fasteners holding the bracket.
6. Slip the seat onto the frame tab and attach the rear bracket to the fender, reusing the stock mounting screw and plastic washer.

NOTE: Drag Specialties seats are designed for use with Drag Specialties sissy bars.
